Fundraising Update

We are incredibly pleased to announce that we were successful in our bid for £75,000 from The National Lottery Cost of Living Fund.

Many of our Baby Bank families face severe financial hardship and lack basic necessities for babies and young children that are often unaffordable in times of crisis. Therefore, this is a huge success as this will help keep our Baby Bank supporting even more families in need.

Additionally, we were awarded £30k by the Youth Music 'Trailblazer' fund to start our Musical Climbers and Creators Project. This is an outdoor activity musical session in Grow Wild, delivered with music-making charity Soundcastle.

Finally, the fundraising team have been working closely with our trustees' fundraising lead, Leonie, to create the charity's inaugural fundraising strategy. This strategy is important in guiding the way our charity approaches and plans its fundraising activities in the future.

Father's Well-being Project One users feedback

1:1 counselling within Fathers Project, was a huge help to me as the dad of a 6-month-old baby.

I have a wonderful daughter and partner, but I also found a lot of the early stages of fatherhood isolating, stressful, and worrying. We had a tricky start and since then I often questioned my ability to handle being a dad, especially when going back to work and trying to fit everything in.

Being able to talk about these issues without any guilt, and with a great listener who understood the issues dads face was really helpful. I feel more confident as a dad and feel better able to handle all of the uncertainty and challenges ahead'.

Our Feed a Family a Christmas Meal appeal aimed to provide a warm, nutritious Christmas meal to families in the Waltham Forest area who are facing food insecurity.

Incredibly, this campaign developed thanks to the help of local fine-dining restaurant, The Rear Window, who saw our campaign and offered to host our families at their lovely restaurant and cook a delicious Christmas meal for them. We're also extremely thankful to Karen Bellamy and The LVE Charitable Foundation who donated £650 to cover the costs of a luxury coach which transported the families to the restaurant. As well as the William Rose Estate Agents and Cash for Kids for advertising and providing presents for our children and families.

The day was a huge success, everyone enjoyed celebrating Christmas together, Santa handed out lots of presents and our families were incredibly well looked after by The Rear Window Team. One Mum said 'she was really thankful and her daughter was happy and excited'.

At the end of the campaign we raised £1,145 which went to supporting families over the winter period. The campaign was also covered by ITV News London and BBC Radio London!

Childcare Support is Expanding

Charitable Foundation

From April 2024, eligible working parents of 2-year-olds will be able to access 15 hours childcare support.

From September 2024, 15 hours childcare support will be extended to eligible working parents of children from the age of 9 months to 3-year-olds.

From September 2025, eligible working parents with a child from 9 months old up to school age will be entitled to 30 hours of childcare a week.

Sustainability

At TLPCC we are continuing our journey towards becoming a more environmentally friendly and sustainable charity.

To start off the year, we invited environmental journalist Donnachadh McCarthy (3 Acorns Eco-Audits) to talk at our training day about ways our charity can become more conscious and act to preserve our environment.

As we want to build brighter futures for children in Waltham Forest we're committed to helping the current and future generations by recognising the importance of eco-friendliness. We've already made some considerable changes by introducing more meat-free meals and have completely cut out all red-meats on our weekly menus. Additionally, we are making sure we use more recycled goods for our projects, we've reviewed our energy consumption and waste, and we're more considerate with where our money goes.

What is the Healthy Start Scheme?

If you're more than 10 weeks pregnant or have a child under 4, you may be entitled to get help to buy healthy food and milk.

If you're eligible, you'll be sent a Healthy Start card with money on it that you can use in various UK shops. The NHS will add your benefit onto this card every 4 weeks.

You can use your card to buy:

- · plain liquid cow's milk
- · fresh, frozen, and tinned fruit and vegetables
- · fresh, dried, and tinned pulses
- infant formula milk based on cow's milk

You can also use your card to collect:

 Healthy Start vitamins – these support you during pregnancy and breastfeeding

 Vitamin drops for babies and young children – these are suitable from birth to 4 years old

Keeping your children safe

It is really important to talk to children and create 'safety rules' with them for when they are at home or out and about. There are things that you can discuss with your child to help them understand how important it is to stay safe.

Your child can help create a 'Your Family Safety List'. This is to help your child recognise some key safety rules to consider on a daily basis.

You can do this fun activity at home by creating your own jigsaw pieces that fit together to display your rules, and your child can decorate them.

Some things on your list could be:

- · Don't talk to strangers
- · Don't run away from your adult
- · Hold hands to cross roads
- Don't eat berries from plants

Why not have a go? As your children get older, you can repeat this and see what new things you can add to the list.
